Thermostats in Units

The thermostat controls the level of heat in your unit. Move the dial from level #1 to level #5 to increase or decrease the heat in your unit. To turn the heat off completely in your unit move the thermostat below level #1 or past level #5.

- Level #1 is the lowest level of heat intensity.
- Level #5 is the highest level of heat intensity.

Thermostats are an upgrade in the units. If you experience problems with the heat level in your unit the thermostat may require repair. Please contact the Office. Owners are responsible for this charge.

Laundry Room Renovations

In September the laundry room underwent renovations. New washers and dryers were installed that you give you more options to wash and dry your clothes. The cost of washing and drying your clothes remains \$1.25 per load.

Two important things to remember are:

- DOES NOT USE POWDER LAUNDRY DETERGENT IN THE DISPENSER as this clogs the washing machines' mechanisms.
- DO NOT REMOVE YOUR LAUNDRY CARD FROM THE CARD READER UNTIL DISPLAYS "REMOVE CARD" OR "PULL CARD OUT" otherwise you may lose money.

Please make sure you remove your items from washers and dryers at the end of your cycle so you do not inconvenience other residents.

Washer Options

- You can select the soil level of your load from heavy to mild. A heavy load will wash for 39 minutes, medium for 33 minutes and light for 23 minutes.
- The cycle type can be selected: 'Normal', 'Perm Press' or 'Delicate/Bulky'
- The temperature of the water can be selected 'Hot', 'Warm' or 'Cold'.

All of these options **must be selected before you push the start button.**

Your clothes and other items **mus**t be in the washer and your washing liquid, softener and bleach **must** be in the dispenser before you push the start button.

DO NOT PUSH THE START BUTTON BEFORE ALL OF THE ABOVE HAS BEEN COMPLETED. DO NOT REMOVE YOUR CARD BEFORE THE CARD READER SHOWS "REMOVE CARD".

Dryer Options

- You can select the temperature cycle.
 'Hot', 'Low Heat', 'No Heat' 'Medium Temperature' or "Delicate'
- You can still add the extra time in 10 minute increments at a cost of 25 cents per 10 minutes. You must remove your card from the card reader after the initial 50 minutes has been selected and place on the card reader for each 10 cents extra 10 minutes.
