Swimming Classes Schedule

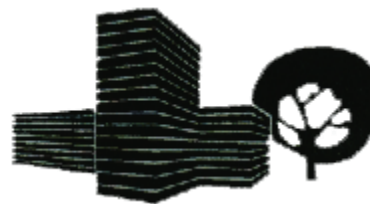
- Swimming Classes will begin July 17, 2018 and run through to August 23, 2018.

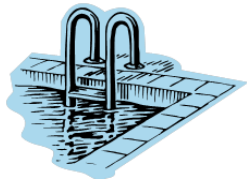


Pool Party June 24, 2018

New Owners and Registered Tenants can sign and pick up their pool tags in the office during office hours. *No one will be allowed admittance to the pool without a pool tag. Lost pool tags cost \$5.00 for replacement.*

Guest swimming in the pool requires a visitor's pass. Visitor's passes must be acquired by the Owner of the property. Owners are allowed no more than two passes at a time; passes are available only from the YCC #41 Office during normal office hours.

Please familiarize yourself with the all Pool Rules and Regulations. Pool Rules and Regulations are posted in the bulletin board by the elevators.

To ensure that children and Adults have a safe and enjoyable swimming experience, please read the below

Facility Swim Test

- Individuals must demonstrate comfort in water and be able to swim a minimum of 2 widths continuously in shallow water.
- If you wish to take pictures of your child while they are swimming, please speak with the lifeguard on duty.

Swimming attire

- Swimmers must change from street clothes to a swim suit and/or clean clothing that permit the individuals to swim safely in the pool.

- Owners must be reminded that they are entirely responsible for their child(ren)/ guest. They must effectively supervise them at all times.
- Child(ren) 10 years and younger must be accompanied by a parent, guardian or designate (caregiver) who is at least 14 years of age and is responsible for their direct supervision. Caregiver must be in bathing attire and within arm's reach of the child(ren) at all times, both in and out of the water. A maximum of four bathers to one parent / guardian (4:1) for non-swimmers. The maximum increases to eight bathers to one parent / guardian (8:1) if lifejackets are worn by all non-swimmers in their charge.

- **Canada Day Fireworks:** Please be reminded, fireworks are strictly prohibited on YCC #41 property. Fireworks pose a significant fire hazard and may do considerable harm to persons or property. Fireworks are especially prohibited to be used on any balcony. (YCC #41, Rules#27);
- **Recreational Equipment:** All seasonal recreational equipment is to be used outside only, and not on the internal common elements or in units (YCC #41, Rule #31).
- **BBQ:** There is no barbequing /cooking on the balconies or storage of any combustible, inflammable material on YCC #41 property (YCC #41, Rules #18 & #27).
- **Seasonal Plants:** Balcony gardening is welcomed; however do not hang flower baskets on the window sills or railings (YCC#41, Rule #12); such decorations could cause damage to person(s) or property should they fall. When watering your plants or cleaning off your balcony, do not pour water off your balcony; the water will fall onto your downstairs neighbors' balcony (YCC#41, Rule #15). Please ensure your air conditioner is installed properly and not dripping water off your balcony.
- Just a reminder that YCC#41 is a **SMOKE FREE** environment. Smoking within 9 meters of the building is strictly forbidden. No smoking is permitted on balconies; do not toss cigarette butts over the balcony / out windows (YCC#41, Rule #15).
