✓ 2018 Major Project Completion:

LED Lighting Project: New LED light fixtures and emergency exit lights have been installed on common element property throughout the building (hallways, basement, garage, stairwells, gym room and laundry room).

LED light bulbs consume less energy to produce the same amount of light as other types of light bulbs. LED light bulbs can last up to 25 times longer than incandescent lamps and use only about 10% of the energy.

External Wall Repair: Repairs to the exterior wall brick work in the 02 / 05 lines has been completed. All broken or damaged bricks have been replaced.

Paving the Visitor's Parking Lot: The cracked and damaged asphalt in the visitor's parking lot has been repaired. All pot holes have been filled. The catch basins in the visitor's parking lot have also been repaired to allow for proper drainage.

Pool Deck: The interlocking brick surrounding the pool has been leveled and re-laid. A new pool shed and pump was installed.

Garden Beds: The main entrance garden beds were renovated this past spring. New garden boarders were constructed and perennial plants were planted.



Heat in the Building & Thermostat Usage

As the weather turns colder, please refer to your thermostat. The thermostat controls the level of heat in your unit. Move the dial from level #1 to level #5 to increase or decrease the heat in your unit.

- Level #1 is the lowest level of heat intensity.
- Level #5 is the highest level of heat intensity.

To turn the heat off completely in your unit move the thermostat below level #1 or past level #5.
