



Pool Rules and Regulations

1. The Lifeguard has **FULL** authority in the pool area at all times.
2. Residents and guests are to respond **IMMEDIATELY** to all Lifeguard requests.
3. During busy periods pool checks will be made. Three whistles means to clear the pool.
4. Residents, **NO TAG MEANS NO ADMITTANCE** to the pool area.
5. When in the pool area, tags must be visible at all times on swimsuit or wrist.
6. Guests: A limit of two guests, per suite per day. Passes available at from the office only.
7. Preference will be given to residents over guest if the pool area is full.
8. All children under the age of 6 must be accompanied by their parent/guardian in the pool and on the pool deck at all times (including the entire duration of the swimming lesson). Children are to be in direct supervision of their parent/guardian and must be within arm's reach in and out of the water, with a maximum ratio of two children for each parent/guardian (2:1). Parent/guardian must be over the age of 16 years.
9. Children 6 – 10 years who fail the swim test are to be in direct supervision of their parent/guardian and must be within arm's reach in and out of the water, with a maximum ratio of two bathers for each parent/ guardian (2:1). Parent/guardian must be over the age of 16 years.
10. Children 6 – 10 years who pass the swim test are permitted to swim unaccompanied, however a parent/ guardian be in direct supervision of their child. The maximum ratio of four bathers for each parent/ guardian (4:1). Parent/guardian must be over the age of 16 years.
11. No smoking, food or beverages are allowed in the pool area.
12. No person with open sores or communicable diseases is allowed to use the pool.
13. Only swim suit attire is to be worn in the pool area.
14. All children under the age of 6 must wear a life jacket at all times in the pool and on pool deck. The life jacket must be supplied by the parent/guardian. Parent/guardian must be over the age of 16 years.
15. The telephone is to be used for emergency use only.
16. No running, pushing or boisterous play is permitted within the pool area.
17. No glass, masks or scuba equipment will be allowed.
18. No pets or animals are allowed in pool or pool area.
19. Pool equipment is to be used by the pool staff only.

20. Children under two years of age and those not fully toilet trained must wear rubber or plastic pants over diapers.
21. Lifeguards will enforce pool rules and policies without exception.
22. Footwear must be worn between suites and pool. Residents without footwear will not be permitted access to the swimming pool.
23. The YCC#4 staff is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
24. Any article left in the pool area will be picked up at the end of the day and held on site for one week after which time it will be discarded.

Child to Adult Safety Swim Regulations:

- Owners must be reminded that they are entirely responsible for their child(ren)/ guest. They must effectively supervise them at all times.
- Child(ren) 10 years and younger must be accompanied by a parent, guardian or designate (caregiver) who is at least 14 years of age and is responsible for their direct supervision. Caregiver must be in bathing attire and within arm's reach of the child(ren) at all times, both in and out of the water
- A maximum of four bathers to one parent or guardian (4:1) for non-swimmers. The maximum increases to eight bathers to one parent or guardian (8:1) if lifejackets are worn by all non-swimmers in their charge.

NOTE: If you wish to take pictures of your child while they are swimming, please speak with the lifeguard on duty.

Swim Test

- Individuals must demonstrate comfort in water and be able to swim a minimum of 2 widths continuously in shallow water.

Swimming Attire

- Swimmers must wear a swim suit.
